IV. Committee Reports:

H. Promotions, Publicity & Website:

1. There was discussion on if we are spending too much on trophies versus giving shooters other options. A big problem with the trophies, they are not being pickup and the shipping costs associated with getting these to the rightful owners after the state shoot high. The was a requested vote by the president on how the trophies that are not picked up should be handled – the vote stated that the trophies are shipped to the shooter as an expense of the state shoot and covered by the club hosting the state shoot.

I. State Shoot Criteria: Nothing to report.

J. Shoot Series: Motion was approved, to continue the Badger series with a max 5,000.00 towards prizes. The shot series committee will decide these prizes from year to year.

J. North & South Zone Shoot: Pat Gerbensky - went well in the south but attendance was low in the north. There needs to be more hype on the shoots for attendance to be raised. This year J&H will host the north zone and West Bend will host the south zone.

VII. New Business

A. Award State Fitasc shoot for 2020: WGC made a requested to be added to the FITASC rotation. WGC was awarded the state for 2020 FITASC and allowed an exception to throw 100 targets event in a day, which will allow more people to shoot the event over the weekend. The FITASC committee has to add/adjust the State FITASC requirements to accommodate the request.

B. Award State Shoot 2020: Game Unlimited.

C. Advertising on Website. Scott Goetzka was unavailable. The selection of a new webmaster has to be completed to advance this area.

D. Badger shoot series: Continuing to do the series, to change the series up a new prize will be selected each year by the committee.

E. New Webmaster for WSCA: Robin has an option for the webmaster, will review and get back to the board within a few weeks.

F. State Shoot Gun Raffle: At the spring meeting the club the hosts the state shoot the next year will bring the tickets for the raffle to all clubs the selected the option of raffle tickets with their renewal. All tickets funds from tickets sold need to come back to the WSCA and then the WSCA will pay back the money to the club the raffle is for. By-laws need to reviewed and adjusted to clarify the use of the raffle permit by clubs in the organization.

G. Extra Funds: There was a concern the income was down over \$5000 from the same time period a year ago. This is due to the additional fund added to the state shoot and an increase of \$1000.00 on the badger series cart.
