

Hall of Fame Nomination Criteria

- Must have accumulated a minimum of 1500 points to qualify for the Hall of Fame.
- Must have been a member of the NSCA for at least 10 years.
- Must have attained a minimum age of 30 years.
- Grandfather rule if a shooter moves out of state, then moves back. Out-of-State Team Membership would count towards HOF points based on Wisconsin HOF points.
- HOF Nomination Committee can award extra service points for any outstanding service by a shooter or officer.

Hall of Fame Nominating Committee

- Chairman: Steve Greene
- Chairman of the HOF Nomination Committee is to be appointed by the WSCA Board. All inductees shall become life members of this committee.
- Chairman can appoint additional members to the Hall of Fame Committee.
- HOF Nomination Committee shall present nominees to the WSCA Board at Spring Meeting. The WSCA Board shall pick inductees to HOF.

Service as an Officer of the WSCA Board (Shooters only)	25
